



Project: The Cranley Hotel, London

This project consisted of the refurbishment of 25 bedrooms, bathrooms and communal areas on 5 separate floor levels.

Works were carried out in phases whilst the remainder of the hotel remained occupied and fully functional.

Following a complete strip out of existing fittings and finishings, works consisted of new electrical and plumbing services throughout, quality joinery including wardrobes and air conditioning casings, new sanitary ware and limestone tiling to bathroom walls and floors.

Close liaison with the Client and hotel staff ensured that all phases were completed on programme and to the quality required.
